Searching for Information About Your College's Disability Services

Information regarding your college's disability services and the process of applying for accommodations may require focused research, as the process is not uniform across all schools. It's a good idea to understand your college's requirements early. You can use this checklist as guidance to jumpstart your research. This video describes what disability offices might look for.

*	Office Information What is the disability services office called? (It may be called something like "student access" or "support services.") When is it open? Where is it located on campus? You can use this database to search for your college.
*	Key Personnel Who is in charge of your school's disability services office? Is there a contact person you can reachout to if you have questions or need assistance?
*	Application Deadlines When is the deadline for requesting accommodations at your college? Make a timeline below of any important due dates for document submissions or meetings.

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*	Types of Documentation What kinds of documentation does your school require in order to file for accommodations? Will they accept your previous IEP or 504 plan? Will you need to have a new assessment?
